- 3 There are various types of pedestrian crossings.
- Identify and describe **four** kinds of pedestrian crossings. (15 marks)
  - What are the main driving skills and attitudes to be emphasised to pupils regarding pedestrian crossings? (5 marks)
- 4 A driving instructor and pupil arrive at the scene of an accident which involves two cars and a motorbike.
- Describe the actions which should be carried out to contain the incident. (20 marks)
